## **Eyeglass Holder Scroll Saw Pattern**

## Instructions

1. Print the pattern. Be sure to print the page at “Actual size” or scaled to 100%.
2. Once printed, you’ll need to secure both pieces to the wood you are scrolling. Once the pattern pieces are cut, you’ll likely need to sand or carve the nose piece to fit your glasses frames. **TIP: You can use a 1x3 piece of lumber and simply chop a 3 1/2” piece of it off for the base rather than scrolling it.** Then you’ll only need to scroll the center hole out.
3. Add a final finish and and insert the nose into the base. You may need to add a little glue depending on how tight the fit is.
