
Instructions


- 1. Print each page of the pattern. Be sure to print the pages at "Actual size" or scaled to 100%. Margins are set to 0.25 inches.
- 2. Once printed, you'll need to match up all the pieces of the pattern and tape together. After the pattern pieces are attached together, you can attach the patterns to your wood and cut.




Sled Rails


The next 6 pages contain the sled rails and will need to be pieced together. The pattern should look like the image below.



















Seat Supports
