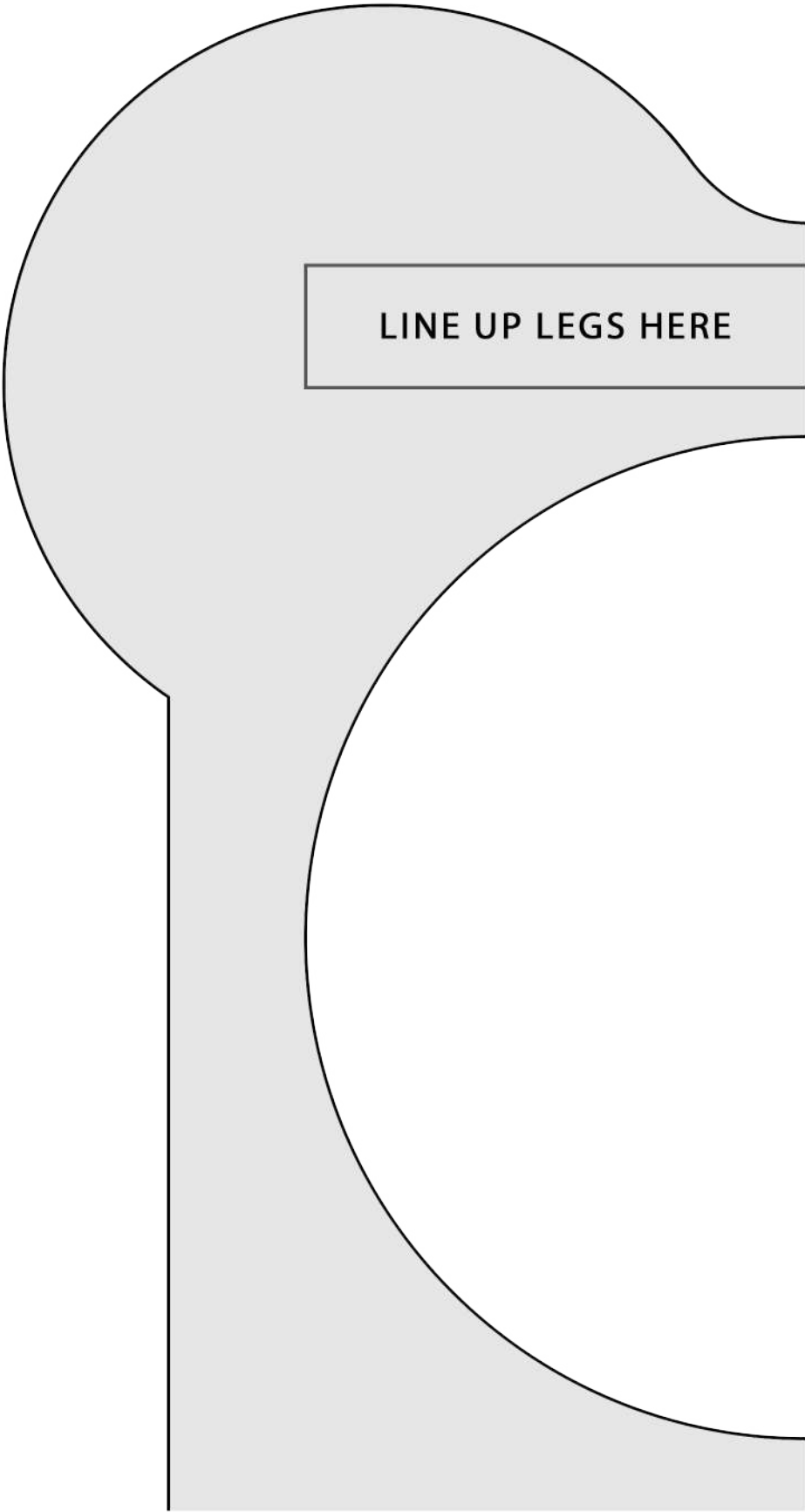

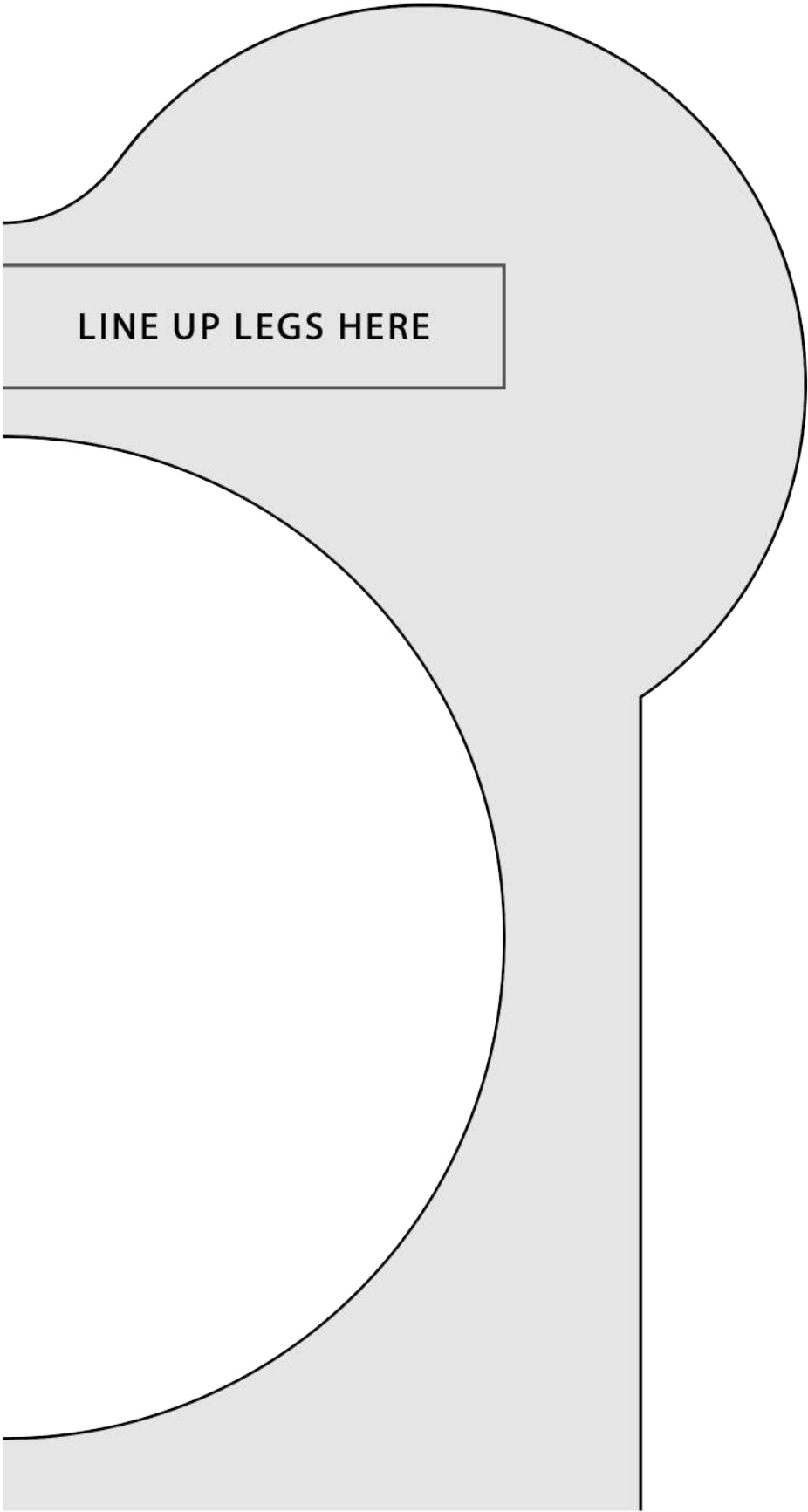
Instructions

1. Print each page of the pattern. Be sure to print the pages at “Actual size” or scaled to 100%.
2. Once printed, you’ll need to match up all the pieces of the pattern and tape together. There are four sections for the base and one page that includes two legs. Once the pattern pieces are attached together, you can attach the assembled patterns to your wood.
3. I recommend using a 12-inch wide 3/4” plank for this project. I used pine for mine.
4. Use a jigsaw, band saw, or scroll saw to cut out all of the pieces.
5. The only assembly required is to attach the legs to the base. The pattern outlines where the legs should go. Do not cut this areas out as they are only used to help you determine where the legs need to attach.
6. Add a final finish and some bowls and give your pooch a delicious meal!

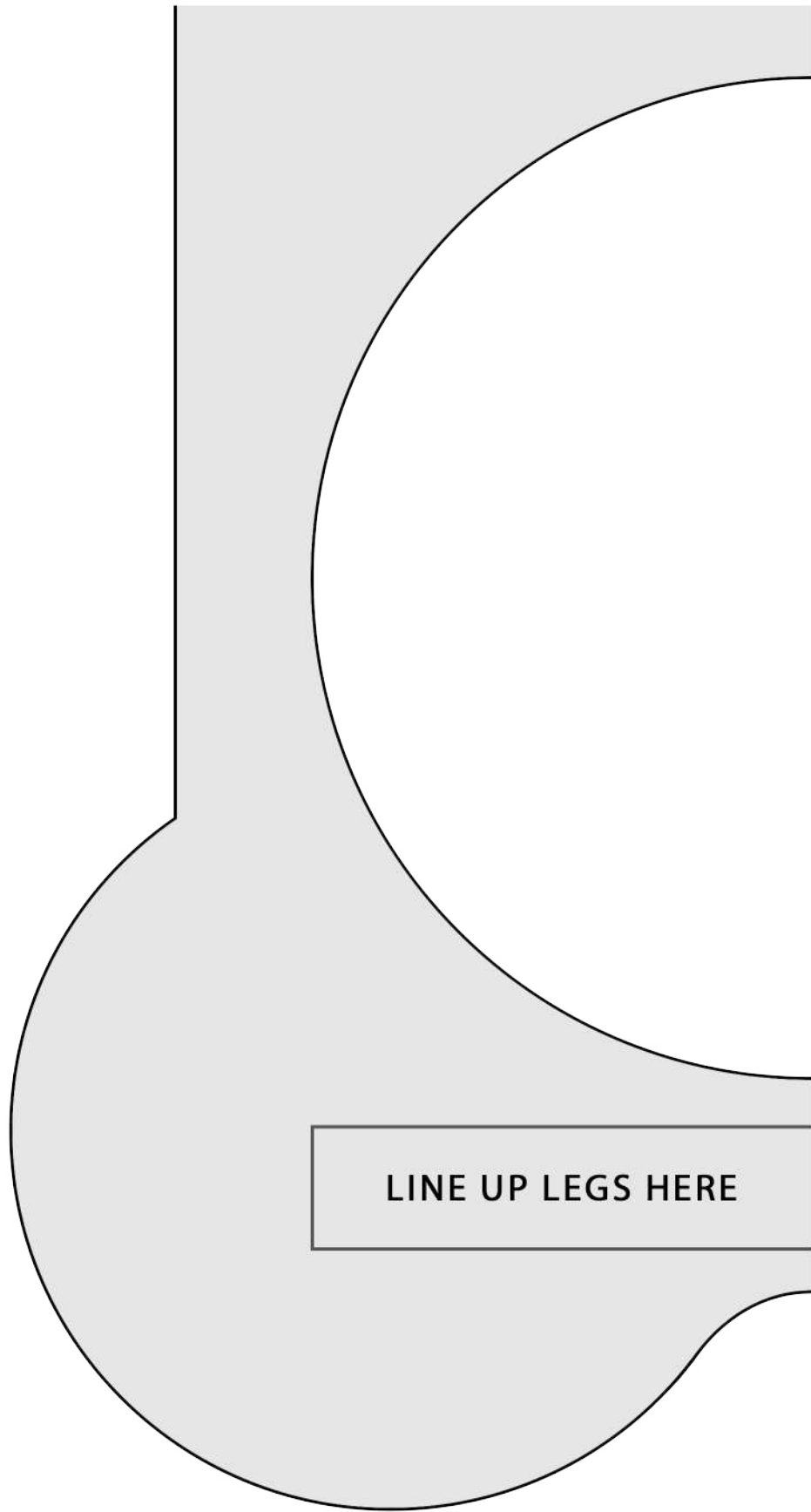

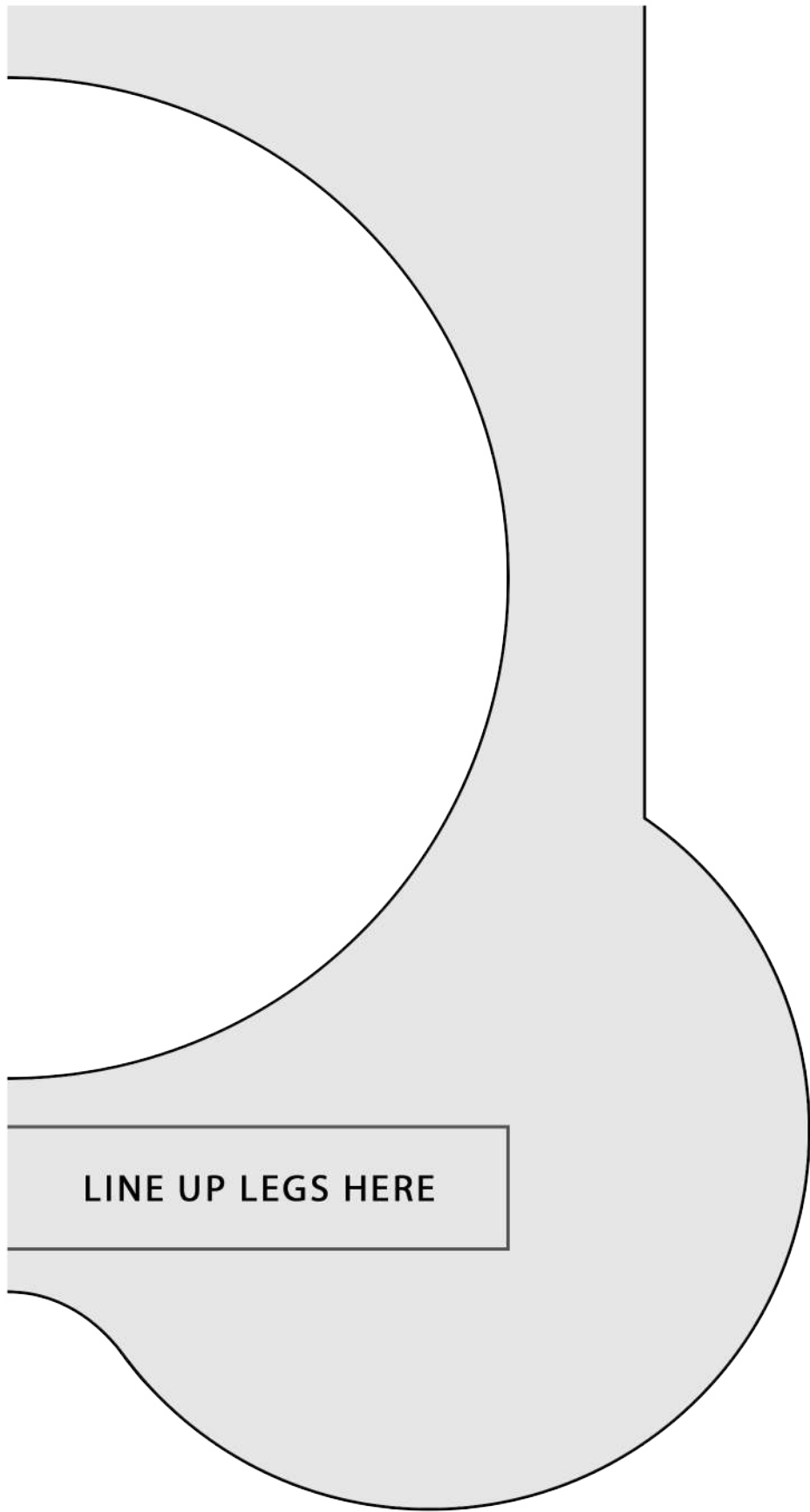
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
